TOPIC: Individual Consonant -C

Soft c

FACT/ TIP: when **c** is followed by **e**, **i** or letter **y**, it makes a soft sound (the sound of letter s) as in cent. **ce/ ci**

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: Soft C says / s/ as in cent

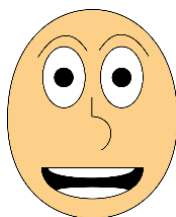
