

VOCABULARY:

TOPIC: GENDER NOUNS

FACTS: Nouns are naming words. Gender tells whether a person is male or female.

Masculine gender: Names of nouns that are linked to males are called **masculine**.

e.g. Father, son, bull

Feminine gender: Names of nouns that are linked to females are called feminine.

eg. Mother, daughter, queen
