TOPIC: Long vowel 'a' ('ay says ā)

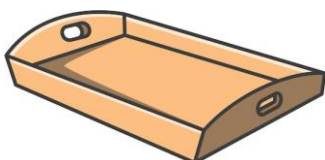
FACT/ TIP: Every letter makes a sound.
