PHONICS

FACT/ TIP: A consonant blend is when two or three consonants are joined together in a word and each letter makes its own sound.

COMPREHENSION

TOPIC: Cause & Effect

FACTS/TIPS: Cause and effect looks at how one thing causes something else to happen.

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: Read the story.

Ted was very tired after school, so he took a bath and went to bed.

Cause	Effect
Ted was tired. - What happened because Ted was tired?	- He took a bath - he went to bed
