

TOPIC: Consonant blend cl-


FACT/ TIP: A consonant blend is when two or three consonants are joined together in a word and each letter makes its own sound.

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: cl- says /cl/ as in clock, cloud

When the noun is more than one the verb **<u>does not</u>** carry the **s**.

COMPREHENSION

TOPIC: Cause & Effect

FACTS/TIPS: Cause and effect looks at how one thing causes something else to happen.

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: Read the story.

Ted was very tired after school, so he took a bath and went to bed.
