PHONICS

FACT/ TIP: When two consonants are joined together and they make one sound it is called a digraph.

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: **ch** says /ch/ as in **cherry, chair**







FACTS/TIPS: The noun and verb must agree.

When the noun is one or singular the verb 'was' is used.

When the noun is more than one or plural the verb 'were' is used.



The boy **was** eating.



The boys **were** eating.
