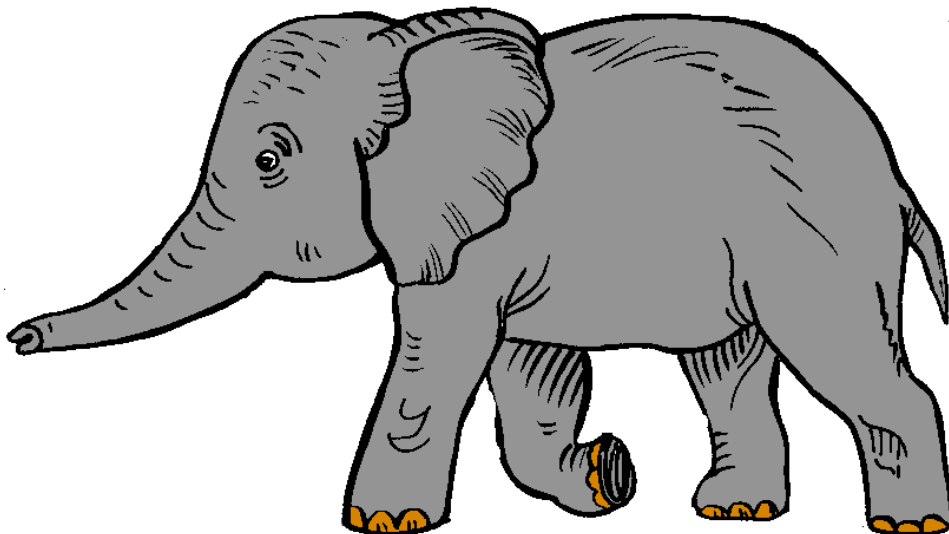

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: E says /eh/ as in elephant.

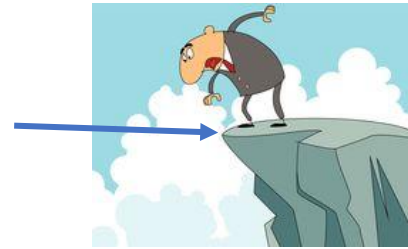



Circle the pictures whose names rhyme with vet.

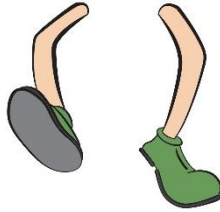


GRAMMAR: NOUNS
