PHONICS

TOPIC: Long vowel 'i' (ie says ī)

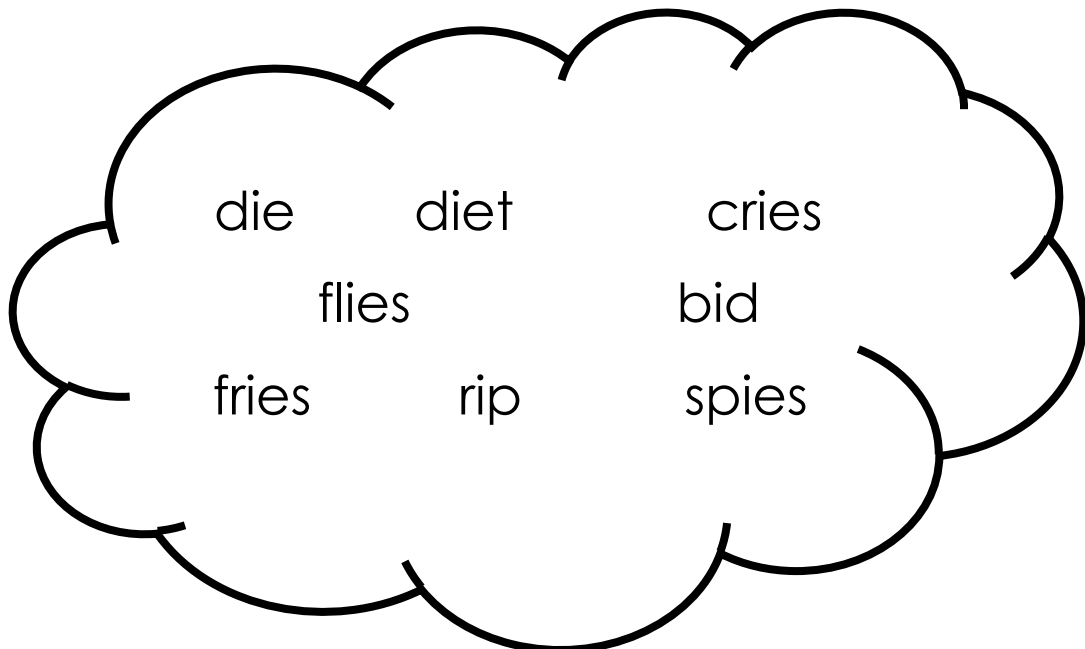
FACT/ TIP: When two vowels comes together the first one says its' name.

She has a big doll. – **She** is used to replace Pam.
