PHONICS

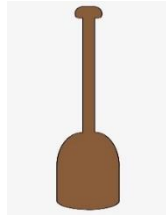
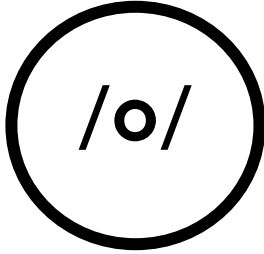
TOPIC: Long vowel 'o' ('oa' says **ō**)
