
PHONICS

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: Words ending with -at


Say /a//t/ as in hat, cat, fat

GRAMMAR

TOPIC: Verb Tense – Present Tense

FACTS/TIPS: Verb tense tells of the time at which an action is done.

Present tense tells the action is happening now. When the noun is one thing or person the verb usually **ends** with -**s**. When the noun is more than one the verb will **not** usually end with -**s**.

PRACTICE EXAMPLES: Some action words are: play, jump, do, run.

The dog (jump) jumps over the fence.
