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#### **PHONICS**


**TOPIC:** Word Families -it

**FACT/TIP**: Word families are groups of words that have something in common. Word families usually have the same end sound.

Say /i//t/ as in hit, kit, fit

My -it family



h + it = hit



k + it = kit
