TIPS:

When we add we **get more**. The plus sign is used to add **+**.

When we subtract we get less. The minus sign is used to subtract **-**.

PRACTICE EXAMPLE: Count, add and write the number



$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \\ +4 \\ \hline 6 \end{array}$$



$$\begin{array}{r} 4 \\ +2 \\ \hline \square \end{array}$$
